The Minecraft Mentor Club meets ***Fridays from 3:15-4:15pm*** in the Library Lab. As a group we work on developing our Minecraft skills by working with redstone and command blocks, potions and enchanting tables. This year we also hope to spend some of our time learning how to develop mods.

Recognizing that all of us have expertise but none of us are experts, part of the role of a Minecraft Mentor is to teach others. Minecraft Mentors might lead workshops for other students or teachers and to develop lessons on using Minecraft in the classroom. Minecraft Mentors will also help develop instructional resources, such as screencasts and tutorials for others to use in developing their skills. Minecraft Mentors do not have to be Minecraft experts, but should demonstrate the following characteristics:

- Responsibility
- Honesty
- Kindness
- Curiosity & Creativity
- Leadership Skills
